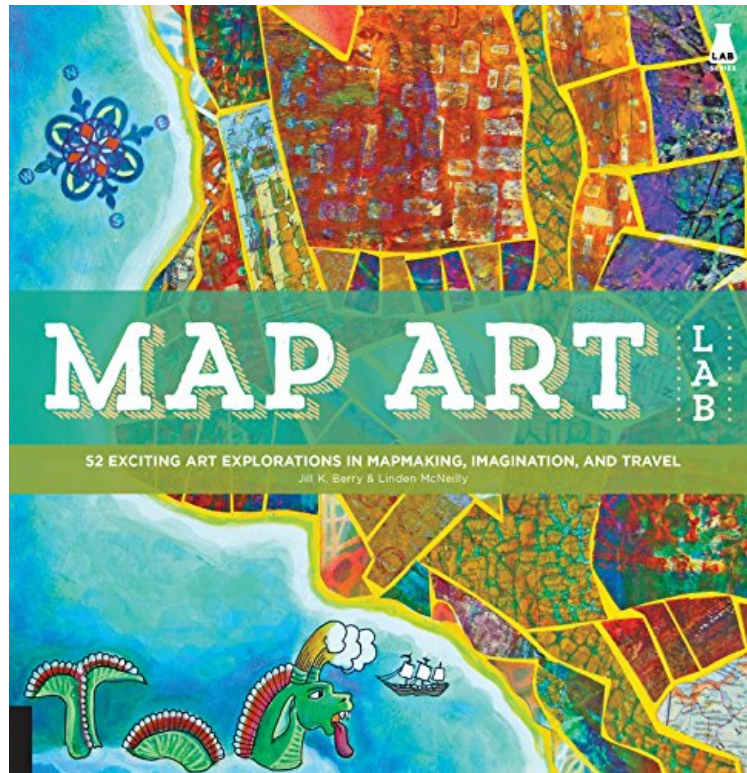

You'll get to draw sea monsters like olden day maps, create all sorts of interesting looking roads, make a pop-up map, a tea-stained treasure map, satellite map of your house and many more.In many cases, you're not making an actually usable map, but a piece of art that's inspired by maps.Some of the projects would require you to collect glass tiles or stones to make a mosaic map, or have a camera or sketchbook in hand and look out for map-like creations from nature, many projects involve drawings, some collages, and other interesting ways to create art.There's a good variety of art inspired projects.It's a very hands-on book, recommended to art and craft lovers.(See more pictures of the book on my blog.
