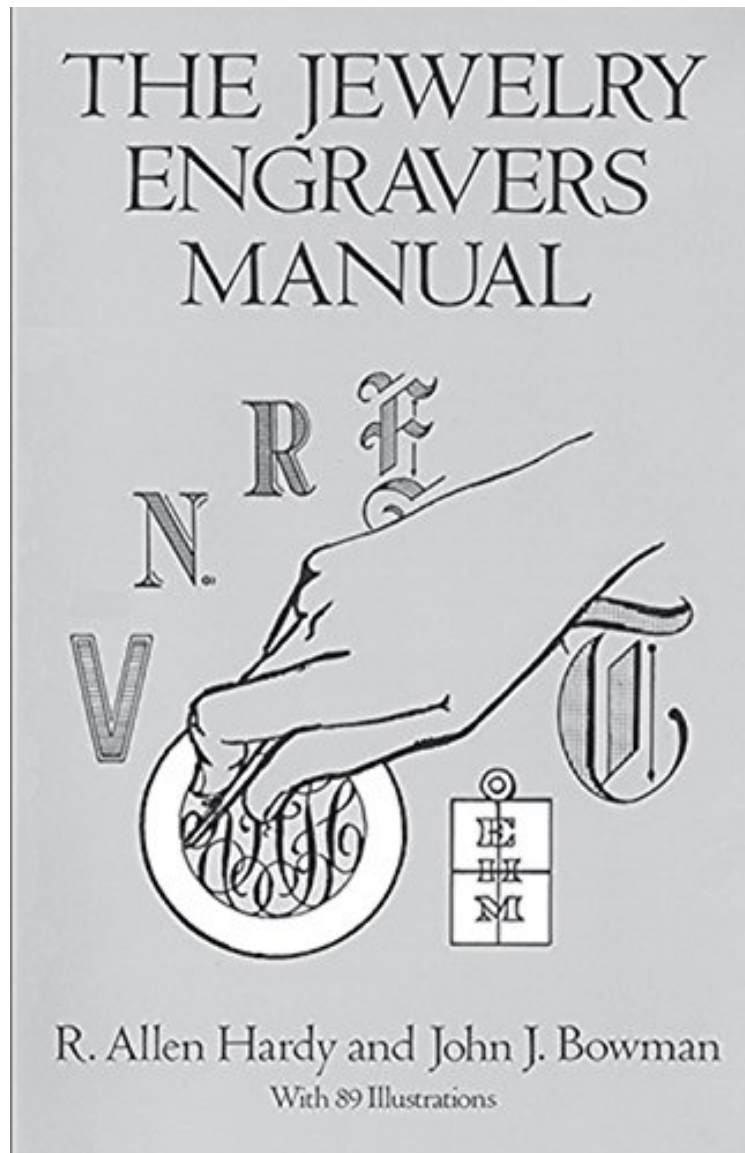

Most are informative and very expensive, but for the basics and beginning techniques get this book before you buy anything else and read it. It was not put out by a manufacturer of air driven gravers (which are handy). It is what you would have been taught back in the 60s and 70s. Master the basics and the advanced techniques come easier. That is what this book does, plus it defines terms, techniques and methods. Do what it says in the book and practice them. After that find a basic course at a local college or sign up for one of the manufacturers classes.
