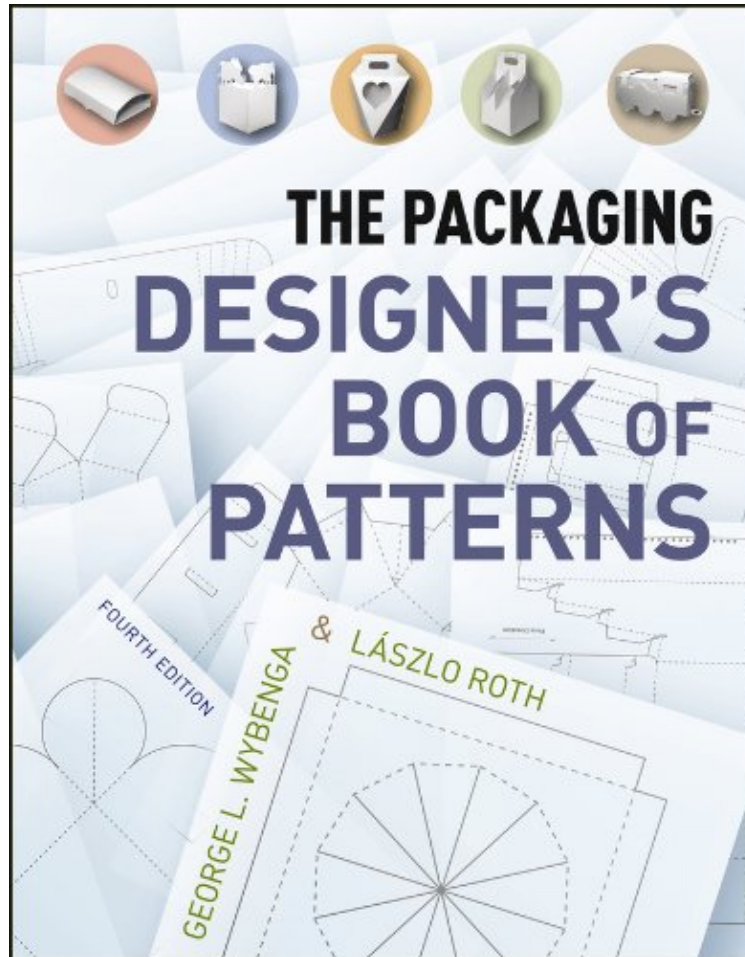

There were no problems using the included key to download the patterns. The electronic file numbers match the page numbers in the book, so it's easy to find the file you want. About file types: I'm working with CS5, so if you have a different version, this info may or may not be the same for you. The files are EPS files, which can be opened in Adobe Illustrator or Photoshop (I have no idea about PS elements). If you open the files in AI, the cut lines, score lines, and glue markings of files I've looked at are in different layer groups. If you open them in PS, EPS files open as a single layer. If you want a PSD layered file, you can open them in AI, and export as a PSD file. Probably the one improvement would be to include PSD versions of the files in the download as so many people use PS or PS elements exclusively. Overall, I'm very happy with this book and the downloadable files. Will have lots of fun using these. Just
